WINE REGION

Villány, southwest of Hungary

EXPOSURE

Városhegy, Mandolás, Dobogó and Pillangó vineyards

SOIL

Limestone bedrock, loess and clay topsoil.

VINES

Density of plantation: 3 m x 1 m, 1,8 m x 0,8 m

CULTIVATION Cordon royat

VINTAGE -2010

Long, snowy winter; rainy and cool spring with fast consistent blooming; diverse summer with extremes of hot and dry and rainy periods. Cooling down at the end of August; variable, rainy September; sunny, dry but cool October.

HARVEST

September 7th - October 3rd
By hand in 15 kg crates.

YIELD: 15-57 hl/Ha

VINIFICATION-MATURATION

We pressed the grapes for Rosé in whole cluster, so it resulted in fine and clear must. Grapes were pressed right away, without maceration; this gives the wine a bright and rosy tone. Alcoholic fermentation was done in stainless steel; temperature was kept between 16 and 20°C. We store the wine in the tanks in order to keep the natural carbon dioxide, which helps to express gentle and smooth acidity.
